Saskatchewan's Biggest, Brightest City is celebrating 132 years of fun with the Saskatoon Exhibition!

The Saskatoon Exhibition Parade will be held this year on Tuesday, August 7th in the downtown area to kick off The EX (August 7-12). The parade begins at 10:00 a.m. on 24th Street and Spadina Crescent, then heads west on 24th Street to 4th Avenue. It will then turn south on 4th Avenue, then east on 20th Street, and then north on Spadina Crescent East to end back at 24th and Spadina Crescent (see map). The parade lasts approximately 1 hour past any one point. It will be completely finished and out of the downtown area by 12:00 noon at the latest.

The marshalling area for parade floats will be along Spadina Crescent between 33rd Street and 24th Street. We will be using Queen Street, starting at 7th Avenue to Spadina Crescent, to marshal equestrian entries. There will also be "No Parking" signs on 8th and 9th Avenues on Tuesday morning.

We want to ensure that everyone is aware well in advance that extra time may be required when travelling to and from the area the morning of August 7th.

An access point into and out of the downtown area will still be available via the Broadway Bridge. In case of an emergency, the parade will be interrupted to allow for emergency vehicle access.

This is a busy summer in Saskatoon and we look forward to another successful Exhibition and Parade.
